

If your test result says *Påvisad*

If your test result says *Påvisad* ('demonstrated'), this means that you have Covid-19.

What to keep in mind and what to do if you have Covid-19

If your test result shows that you have an ongoing infection with Covid-19, it is important that you stay home to avoid infecting others. You also have to follow the Infectious Diseases Act (*smittskyddslagen*). If your test result says *Ej påvisad*

If your test result says *Ej påvisad* ('not demonstrated'), this means that there was no virus in your sample. Once your symptoms are gone and you feel entirely healthy, you can go back to living a normal life.

If your illness deteriorates, you should call 1177 Vårdguiden or your local health centre (*vårdcentral*). If your life is in danger, call 112.

Your test result only shows if there was any virus in the sample you left. There is a small risk that your result may be a false negative if there was too little material in the self-sample you took. This means that you may have Covid-19 after all, which is why it is important for you to stay home until you feel entirely healthy.

If your test result says *Ej bedömbär*

If your test result says *Ej bedömbär* ('impossible to evaluate'), this means that it was not possible to analyse your sample or to evaluate the test result. This may be because something happened at the laboratory that made the sample impossible to analyse, or it may be due to a technical error.
